While it is written in Easy Read it can be hard for some people to read a document this long.


Some things you can do to make it easier are:



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What the Napier City Council does



Napier is a city in the North Island of New Zealand.



The **Napier City Council** looks after the services that makes Napier a great place for everyone to live.



The services the Council looks after are:

• local roads and footpaths



water





- sewerage (what happens after we flush the toilet)
- rubbish and recycling



Some other services the Council looks after are:

- outdoor spaces like:



- o playgrounds
- \circ parks
- \circ sports fields
- libraries

- swimming pools
- dog registration (money that is paid by owners to the Council)
- Civil Defence (for example being ready if we have an earthquake).

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What is a Long Term Plan?








A **Long Term Plan** is a plan for the next 10 years for our:

- activities
- major projects
- how much money we will get
- how much new things will cost
- what our **rates** will be.



A Long Term Plan is also called a LTP.

We review our LTP every 3 years.

Rates and costs



Councils help local communities run smoothly by running lots of services.

Rates are a kind of tax that are paid by people who own:





- houses
- buildings.

Rates are used by your council to pay for services.



Keeping our rates low has been important to us.









Our rates are going to be higher over the next 10 years.

Some of the things that affect the choices we make are:

- climate change making sure we are able to deal with the changes climate change is causing
- COVID-19 making sure we have enough money to help people after losing money from COVID-19
- 3 waters reform making our water services better - see page 13 for more about this
- deferred renewals things that need to be fixed but cannot be as there is not enough money.



We do not have enough money to fix everything at the same time.



We are making a list of what are the most important things to fix.



We plan to save money over the next 10 years so we do not have to wait to fix things again.

3 Waters Reform



When we say **3 waters** we mean:

• drinking water



• stormwater or rainwater

• wastewater which is dirty water.



Reform means making something better.



The Government has made a new organisation called **Taumata Arowai**.



From 1 July 2021 Taumata Arowai will look after water services in New Zealand.


Water, stormwater and wastewater



Water

We want to make sure that Napier:

• has clean water to drink and swim in



• has clean waterways in our parks.



To improve how we get our water we want to:

- build new water treatment plants
- find new water underground.





We also want to build 3 new reservoirs.

Reservoirs are places to collect water.



For this to happen we have bought land at Mataruahou (Napier Hill).

Stormwater



Most of our stormwater goes to Ahuriti Estuary.




We want to start cleaning our stormwater to help the Ahuriti Estuary.

Wastewater



We know keeping our seas clean is an important issue for the people living in Napier.

We want to make sure our wastewater is clean before it goes to the sea.




We have 2 options on how to manage our water supply:

Having this space as a regional park would mean we can look after the land and waterways in the area better.








We have 2 options:



Te Pihinga is a new community building in Napier.






We have 3 options on what do about Te Pihinga:

- 1. finish it now 2021 to 2023
- 2. finish it later 2023 to 2025
- 3. do not finish it.



We would like to finish it later which means finishing it between 2023 and 2025.

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Housing



We know that housing is an important issue for many people.



Community housing is also going to cost more.



Community houses are houses owned by the government.



We have almost 4 hundred community housing units across Napier.

These community housing units are:



- getting old
- need fixing.





Fixing up our community housing units needs to be done by 2024 to pass housing rules.

Most of our money that we set to do this has been used.



We are looking over our options for what community housing will look like in the future.






We have 2 options on how to deal with our housing situation:

- 2. use money from rates.

• how much it will cost.








While we wait for the research to finish we have 2 options:

Community safety



Safety is important to us all.

When we feel safe:



- we can about go about our lives easily
- our feelings of being part of the community is strong.



We want to make our public spaces safer.



Every year we put money into programs that help keep Napier safe like **street patrols**.



Street patrols are groups of people that walk around the streets to keep them safe.



We want to look into how **street ambassadors** would work in supporting our community.



Street ambassadors are people that help people living on the streets to find support.






We have 2 options here:

- spend money to set up a street ambassadors program that would start in 2022
- 2. keep things as they are with our street patrols.

Traffic safety plans



We also know that keeping traffic down to help keep our streets safe is important.



Some of the things we do to make to things safer are to put in:

- speed bumps to slow down cars
 - bollards to stop cars going on things like footpaths
- bicycle lanes.



Every year we write 1 traffic plan help manage traffic to keep our streets safe.




We want to be able to write 3 traffic plans every year so that we can make our streets safer.

We have 2 options:

- 1. make 3 plans each year
- 2. only make 1 plan each year.



We think we should make 3 plans each year.






